COTTON BUDS, COTTON PADS DIMA REBUS 06-09 - 31.10.2023

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Dima Rebus was born in 1988 in Naberezhnye Chelny, Russia. Lives and works in London, UK. His main mediums are watercolour paintings, installations, and sculptures, which allow him to explore the process of chemical transformation of materials. Rebus is the mastermind behind the Underground Aquarellka universe, which focuses on the anatomy of human behaviour, and the evolution of social mores.

Rebus is known for his large-scale watercolours, created using his signature components and rainwater collected from different parts of the globe. The pH of rainwater varies depending on the environmental situation in every location. Rebus uses this data when working with pigment granulation, and the finished watercolour paintings comprise comprehensive topographic maps featuring sediments from different countries and regions. Rebus's complex paintings bring together the aesthetics of abstraction, cartoon, and realism, with the principal style of the works perpetuating the general mood of suspense and unintentional mysticism. The Underground Aquarellka universe created by Rebus fills up with internal metaphysical images in line with spur-of-the-moment plot twists.

Among the key focuses of Rebus's artistic practice is exploring themes of adaptive social norms and their evolution in contemporary society. In the world he put together, alarmist sentiments are replaced by a more philosophical, detached view that accepts the facts of isolation or extinction as natural stages of the living cycle. Meticulously constructed compositions allude to the artist's passion for gaming culture and his early experiences with digital interactives.



Dima Rebus presents works from the series **Cotton Buds**, **Cotton Pads** (2011– present) specially for the show at LOBBY. The artworks have been selected from the artist's personal archive and introduced to the public for the first time; some of the works have been finished as recently as 2023. The exhibition also features works from private collections and large-scale watercolours from one of the artist's key series, Exoplanet.

Cotton Buds, Cotton Pads is a series of works from 2011–2013, which in many ways paved the way for the artist's future practice. In the works from the series, Rebus makes one of his early attempts to grasp the concept of adaptive norms, which becomes ingrained throughout the artist's subsequent series. The surreal scenes serving as an example of a reverse cargo cult, shape the narrative about imitation practices thriving under certain circumstances.












Chemical solutions, gypsum, rain water and watercolour on paper 110 x 90 \mbox{cm}










The State 14, 2022

Chemical solution, gypsum, rain water and watercolour on paper 155 \times 105 cm


















Albion 19, 2012 (2023)
